Bethany, you should obviously keep whatever records you have.

Haritos' lawsuit, if he files one, will presumably concern the documents that Abretske has already produced to you in response to Haritos' earlier public records requests, some of which documents were not produced to Haritos. Some of those records were apparently not given to Haritos because they concerned personal matters and not matters relating to the business of this office. I assume that you, with the help of Dennis Carpenter, kept separate copies of those documents that were produced to Haritos, and those that were not produced to him. The latter will be at issue in the lawsuit if it is filed, and they should obviously be preserved.

Haritos' 12/1 request to preserve letter goes far beyond those documents, however, requesting that the Office preserve all types of electronic data. The letter goes into technical computer matters that I know nothing about. It should be forwarded to John Abretske and inquiries should be made of John as to what Office policies are with respect to the preservation and destruction of electronic data. He should be instructed that all data relating to Haritos and Scot's and others' references to Haritos should be preserved. Presumably this Office has received preservation requests similar to this one in other matters, and John may have some protocols for effecting a hold along the lines requested in Haritos' 12/1 letter.

As to many of Haritos' other demands, several of which I'll highlight in an attachment to an email subsequent to this, I really have no idea what we should be doing. I believe the Office has established a committee to develop policies related to e-discovery matters such as this, and they may be able to provide some guidance. For example, on p. 4 of his letter, Haritos asks that with respect to Teasdale, Bethany and me, our ESI systems, media and devices should be removed from service and sequestered. If we deem that impractical, we should "forensically image" those items. He makes many technical requests, and I don't know to what extent this Office would be willing to comply. Again, others with more experience than I will need to be consulted.

A couple of final comments. Haritos obviously didn't draft this. In fact, it appears to be a slightly modified version of a document that some attorney mailed to a future defendant in a federal lawsuit. In the first complete paragraph on p. 2, the letter references the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and recent amendments to those rules. Any lawsuit alleging an agency's non-compliance with the State's public records laws should be filed in Maricopa County Superior Court, not federal court.

Second, this Office has an obligation to maintain public records in accord with State law. If someone requests public records, we have an obligation to produce them, subject to several exceptions. As far as I know, we have an obligation to produce them as they exist in the ordinary course. As far as I know, when John produced the stack of documents in response to Haritos' public records requests, he produced everything in our system as it existed at that time that was response. I think that is all that we are obligated to do under public records laws. The hard copies of what John produced represent the AG's documents that would be responsive to Haritos' public records request, and those that we refused to produce are the proper subject of a legal

challenge. In my view, this is not a typical litigation matter in which metadata and changes to metadata might be of consequence. John presumably printed off everything that existed at the time, and that is the public record. That is what Haritos is entitled to, subject to certain exceptions. Whether metadata constitutes a public record is something that I have no knowledge or opinion on; that opinion would have to come from a public records lawyer.

Finally, as to whether you should respond to Haritos' letter, I don't know if we have a policy in this regard when we get similar "hold" letters. I know of nothing obligating us to do so. While we should do all that we have to do in terms of complying with the law, I suggest that we do nothing beyond that in terms of communicating with him. His MO is to endlessly harass people, and I would not fall all over myself assisting him.

Sorry for the rambling email. Call me if you have any questions or if you think I could be of assistance in working with John Abretske. Again, if you do respond to Haritos, given my lack of knowledge re: computer technical matters and my lack of knowledge of the Office's litigation hold and e-discovery response policies (if any), you may have to get assistance from others in preparing that response.

Haritos' lawsuit, if he files one, will presumably concern the documents that Abretske has already produced to you in response to Haritos' earlier public records requests, some of which documents were not produced to Haritos. Mark, thank you for the compliment. Cindy has been doing a large part of this RFP process and I enjoy hearing that we are doing our part.

As you know, we have completed the phase of writing the RFP, advertising it, accepting the proposals and the initial evaluation of proposals.

The demo phase allows us to see the software and the people behind the software. And while we ask questions during the demonstrations a lot of the answers to the questions need to be made a part of the vendors proposal. We will do a meeting to discuss the demos and put together a list of questions for each vendor. I believe this is scheduled for next week.

We will send "Discussion Letters" to each asking them to respond to these questions to provide clarity to their proposal and insure they are responding to all the features we want the software to include. We will give them approximately a week to respond. Once we receive the responses, we will meet again and evaluate the responses and decide if we have additional questions, want to eliminate any of the vendors from further consideration, or negotiate anything. This can include cost, hours or features. We are trying to build our contract. We can repeat the discussion letters as often as we need, but need to evaluate the responses each time.

Once Discussions have been completed, we send a request for "Best and Final Offer". This is the official notice that discussions are complete. Once Best and Final Offers have been received we cannot go back for any additional information. We finalize the evaluation based on the Information provided and the committee recommends an award. The Procurement Officer determines that the recommendation is accepted or if other processes should be taken.

Typically award is made, procurement receives insurance information and we put the contractor to work. There is a protest period that Procurement typically deals with but vendors are allowed to protest our decision.

I suspect you are looking for an overall time for all this to happen. My best guess would be at least another 6 weeks from now. More if the discussion phase goes very long. A lot of that time will be response time for the vendors to respond to our questions and time spent trying to schedule meetings. We will do our best to keep the process moving.

I am trying to be brief, so if you want any additional detail on the process please let me know.

Tolleson Union High School District (District) alleged financial misconduct by Brenda Busse, the former bookstore manager of Tolleson Union High School (TUHS). allegations are that Ms. Busse stole customer cash payments made at the TUHS bookstore and used them for her own personal purposes by manipulating computer dates to conceal her actions. The monies that were stolen were monies paid by parents, students, and other individuals for various fees and extracurricular activity tax credit donations. This money should have been deposited into the District's accounts. The State alleges that Ms. Busse obtained \$120,707.65 between July of 2007 and June of 2011. On December 14, 2015, the State Grand Jury indicted Ms. Busse on one count of Fraudulent Schemes and Artifices, Theft, and Misuse of Public Monies.

Yesterday, Phx PD Vice assisted Tempe PD in conducted an inspection on one of the four massage parlors with which Brady Wilkins is assisting Tempe PD. Brady/Sandra is submitting a case opening today through our office today and will be asking for subpoenas. Is there a way we can "fast-track" the case opening such that we can begin the subpoena process for the following reasons. Brady briefed me this AM on the inspection and advised this appears to be a more direct Human Sex Trafficking-situation, based on:

- 1. FinCEN and other database information revealed that the Mama-san managers appear to have Flushing, New York ties (a base to which these girls are trafficked).
- 2. There were cots in the massage parlor that was inspected and the girls admitted living at the massage parlor.
- 3. When PPD and TPD went in to conduct the inspection, they were greeted by a young Asian female, who was standing behind a secured counter window. After they identified themselves as police officers, the Mama-san went to the back room and yelled something in Mandarin Chinese to the working girls. When the officers got into the back of the massage parlor, the working girls were all dressed in sweats.
- 4. Brady said that the living arrangements and manner of dress is consistent with an associated massage parlor in Mesa.
- 5. Based on the inspection, the PPD Vice Detectives that helped Tempe PD believe this has markings of Human Sex Trafficking.

As a FYI, the covert camera on the massage parlor that was inspected shows 173 customers in 3 days. Based on a PPD undercover operation that occurred last week, where one of the females agreed to commit an act of prostitution for \$140.00, the earnings potential based on the camera activity is \$33,000.00 in 3 days. With respect to the UC operation, when the PPD officer handed the prostitute the \$140.00 for the sex act, the prostitute left the room with the door open. The UC watched as the prostitute handed the \$140.00 to a Mama-san managing the activity. When the prostitute returned, the session was terminated (before the sex act was initiated) in a manner that assured the UC's ability to return. As the UC was leaving, he was met by the Mama-san, who refunded \$100.00 of the \$140.00. The Mama-san then invited the UC back for sex and asked that he use the back door. Also, Tempe PD used Brady's GPS Tracking Affidavit and Search Warrant as a go-by and authored two GPS tracking warrants that were signed last night. Again, Brady and Keith Thomas are assisting Tempe PD and we will take on more of a roll assisting them with surveillance and other technical investigative support. We have scheduled a meeting with the Tempe PD Commander and Sergeant conducting this investigation, Eric Rothblum, Kalon Metz, Mike Bailey, Chad Brink, Brady and I in the FRS Briefing Room on the 7th, at 1400 hours.

On May 30, 2012, a search warrant was served at the residence of Laveen, Arizona, as part of an investigation by the Tempe Police Department Special Investigations Bureau. The residence was the home of Luz Mendivil and her family members. The search of the residence located multiple stashes of currency totaling \$25,364.00.

That day, the currency was seized for evidence and, subsequently, it was seized for forfeiture as part of CV2012-011279. The currency was forfeited pursuant to a judgment dated September 20, 2012. See Item 2.6 of the *Appendix One* to the enclosed *Judgment: Order of Forfeiture In Rem; Findings of Fact; & Conclusions of Law.*

In 2013, I believe the currency was distributed to the agencies' RICO accounts.

More recently, an attorney for Ms. Mendivil and her family asserted on their behalf an interest in \$20,601 of the \$25,364 seized and forfeited currency. More specifically, the Mendivils assert an interest in:

- \$2,000.00 located in a boot in the master bedroom closet, evidence item #1;
- \$33 located on the shelf in the master bedroom closet, evidence item #2;
- \$4,300.00 located under the nightstand in the master bedroom, evidence item
 #6:
- \$7,000.00 located in a manila envelope inside of a black shoe in the southeast bedroom closet, evidence item #8;
- \$2,975.00 located under a pair of jeans in the East side middle bedroom closet, evidence item #9;
- \$4,000.00 located on the shelf of the East hallway closet, evidence item #10; and
- \$293.00 located in a purse inside a 2007 Chevy Avalanche, evidence item #14.

See Incident Report No. 12-068968 and Incident Report Narrative-Supplemental.

I have evaluated this matter and determined the currency should be returned. In particular,

the following sums should be returned to the following individuals:

Ferndando Granillo: \$2,975.00 plus interest from 5-30-12; Luz Mendivil: \$6,626.00 plus interest from 5-30-12; Maritza Granillo: \$4,000.00 plus interest from 5-30-12; and Monica Granillo: \$7,000.00 plus interest from 5-30-12.

I, as attorney for the State, make this determination pursuant to authority established in A.R.S. § 13-4308(A), which states in pertinent part:

If, on inquiry and examination, the attorney determines that the proceedings probably cannot be sustained or that justice does not require the institution of such proceedings, he shall notify the seizing agency and immediately authorize the release of the seizure for forfeiture on the property or on any specified interest in it.

and from A.R.S. §13-4306(A), which states in pertinent part, "[T]he attorney for the state may authorize the release of the seizure for forfeiture of the property if forfeiture or retention is unnecessary...." Additional authority for this determination comes through the *Judgment: Order of Forfeiture In Rem; Findings of Fact; & Conclusions of Law.*

Because the \$20,601.00 to be returned was previously divided between Tempe P.D. and the State, with 80% remaining with Tempe P.D. and 20% distributed to the State, I propose Tempe P.D. issue a lump sum check to the State in the amount of \$16,480.80, which is 80% of \$20,601.00, plus interest from May 30, 2012, to the date the check is issued. This check should be made payable to "Arizona Attorney General" and indicate on the memo line "CV2012-011279." The State will then combine these monies with monies previously distributed to the State and issue payments to the individuals in the total amounts detailed above.

Initially, Tempe P.D. held the currency, calculated the State's 20% share, then sent the State's share in two distributions in 2013. The State's share was lumped in with distributions from other cases, however, so it would be very difficult for the State to calculate the interest previously distributed to the State. Please identify that portion of the State's distributions that constituted interest earned on the State's 20% share of \$20,601.00.

Finally, please send the 80% lump sum check and the interest calculations to: Arizona Attorney General's Office, Attn: Anne Formanek, Seized Property Manager, CRM/FRS, 1275 W. Washington St., Phoenix, AZ 85007.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The property described in Appendix One is within the jurisdiction of the Superior Court, having been seized within this State.
- 2. All persons known to have an interest in the property have been timely served with Notice of Pending Forfeiture in compliance with A.R.S. § 13-4307.
- 3. No persons known to have an interest in the property, despite having been timely served with Notice of Pending Forfeiture, have filed a claim as required by A.R.S. §13-4311(E) establishing that the property is either exempt from forfeiture, or is not subject to forfeiture, as required by A.R.S. §13-4304.
- 4. The State has presented evidence and information, by Application for Order of Forfeiture and accompanying exhibits thereto, demonstrating probable cause to find and conclude that the property listed in Appendix One was monies, property and/or other things of value used or intended to be used in any manner or part to facilitate the commission of an offense included in the definition of racketeering in A.R.S. § 13-2301(D)(4) and is therefore subject to forfeiture pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-4301 through A.R.S. § 13-4315.
- 5. The showing of probable cause has satisfied this Court that forfeiture pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-2314 and to A.R.S. § 13-4301 through A.R.S. § 13-4315 is authorized as to the property described in Appendix One.
- 6. Probable cause having been shown, the time for making claims having expired (see A.R.S. § 13-4311(D)), and no potential claimant having filed a claim as required by A.R.S. § 13-4311(E), the Court is obliged by A.R.S. § 13-4314 to order the property listed in Appendix One forfeited to the State for allocation as prescribed by A.R.S. § 13-4315.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-4314(A), all right, title and interest in the property described in Appendix One is forfeited to the State of Arizona, Office of the Attorney General and the Tempe Police Department, including contractual rights of any kind affording a source of influence over the property, such as rights of redemption.
- 2. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-4314(B), the State has clear title to the forfeited property and title to said property and its proceeds vested in the State on the commission of the act or omission giving rise to forfeiture.
- 3. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-4314(D), the Attorney for the State may transfer good and sufficient title to any subsequent purchaser or transferee, and the title shall be recognized by all courts, by this State and by all departments and agencies of this State and any political subdivision. Title shall pass free of any and all liens or encumbrances, including racketeering liens filed pursuant to A.R.S. § 13-2314.02.
- 4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to transmit all monies described in Appendix One, if any, together with all interest accrued thereon since its deposit with the Clerk, to the Attorney General's Anti-Racketeering Revolving Fund for allocation in conformance with A.R.S. § 13-4315.
- 5. The Court has determined that there is no just reason for delay and it is therefore directed that judgment as provided herein shall be entered forthwith.
