

CRIMINAL DIVISION:



BORDER CRIMES SECTION:

Lindsay St. John has joined the BCS Section. Lindsay was a prosecutor working at the Pima County Attorney's Office since 2006 where she handled complex felonies. Welcome Lindsay!





Marie Karmes was promoted to Legal Assistant in BCS! Congrats Marie!

Section Chief Kim Ortiz was recognized the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Phoenix Division, for excellence. "professional her leadership. outstanding contributions and successes in schemes fraud prosecuting Arizona." In one case, Herbert Ivan Kay was convicted on two counts of Fraudulent Schemes following a



lengthy investigation. Over the course of 13 years, Kay built a Ponzi-type scheme in which he infused business LLCs with new investor money, and then used that money to help pay for the pre-existing business debts and obligations. Many of Kay's failed enterprises hinged on false misrepresentations and material omissions made to new investors. Kay was sentenced to five years in prison, followed by a consecutive term of probation and was ordered him to pay over \$8 million dollars in restitution to victims. In the second case, Michael Allen Fricker, a principal of Salt River Solar & Wind, LLC (SRSW), was convicted on Fraudulent Schemes and Conducting a

another ienathy following Enterprise Criminal investigation. SRSW's business model relied on grant programs and incentives from Tucson Electric Power (TEP) for solar and other renewable energy project developers to receive a direct federal grant in lieu of an investment tax credit. TEP's rebate program offered a cash incentive for consumers to install renewable energy - specifically solar panel systems. After SRSW installed the solar panel system, TEP would inspect the system, and then issue the rebate check to SRSW. However, in several instances, SRSW failed to reimburse customers as agreed, even though TEP had issued the rebate incentive checks to SRSW. The TEP program is now defunct, due largely to fraudulent practices like those of SRSW. In May, 2015, Fricker was sentenced to five years in prison, followed by a consecutive term of probation, and was ordered him to pay \$1 million dollars in restitution to his victims.

DRUG & RACKETEERING SECTION:

The Unit's investigative focus is on those individuals who engage in organized criminal activity and those individuals who have demonstrated overt violent criminal proclivities. On December 11, 2015, Katrin Nelson will conclude her lengthy career with the AGO. Katrin began work as an AAG for the Arizona Healthcare Cost Containment System Fraud Unit in 1985 to 1986, and for the RICO Section of the Financial Fraud Division from 1986 to 1988. Katrin also worked for several years as a City of

Phoenix prosecutor and as the Acting Director of the Civil Rico Drug Enforcement Project of the National Association of Attorneys General in Washington, D.C. Katrin rejoined FRS in May 1990 where she has worked on wide range of racketeering matters. Good luck Katrin!



In October, FRS worked closely with the SGO to intervene in and defend a pending federal lawsuit that challenges the constitutionality of Arizona forfeiture laws. Though the matter is pending, the SGO and FRS prepared and filed a detailed motion to dismiss the claims in the federal lawsuit this fall.

Kenneth Hughes recently participated in a multi-agency investigation of two Valley smoke shops suspected of selling the dangerous drug "spice." The investigation was conducted by the Mesa Police Department with the assistance of the AGO, Department of Public Safety, Drug Enforcement Administration and Scottsdale Police Department. Tens of thousands of individually-packaged hits of spice were seized, in addition to over \$850,000 of suspected drug proceeds. A forfeiture action is pending.

Eric Rothblum supported a lengthy financial crimes investigation into a suspected \$4 million prostitution ring. The ring operated under the guise of massage parlors throughout the Phoenix area. Pursuant to service of a seizure warrant secured by FRS, and coordinated to coincide with service of search warrants and arrests, the State seized real estate, bank accounts, vehicles, jewelry and other luxury items believed to be instruments or proceeds of prostitution. Criminal charges are pending and the criminal case is being prosecuted by Kalon Metz in FSP. The investigation was conducted in conjunction with FSP, SIS and the Arizona Financial Crimes Task Force.

HEALTHCARE FRAUD & ABUSE SECTION:

Faisal Ullah obtained a 4-year prison sentence in September against Edward Sayegh, M.D. Sayegh was also ordered to pay \$42,920 in restitution. This was a multi-agency investigation with SIS, led by SA Travis Williams, and the United States Drug Enforcement Administration. The positive impact of stopping the distribution of prescription pain medicine that had funneled through the Phoenix medical office of Dr. Sayegh is significant. The estimated street value of the prescription pain pills being improperly distributed had a street value of five million dollars. Great job!

Jesse Delaney obtained a 5-year prison sentence in November against Marcus Brent who pled guilty to Theft/Financial Exploitation of a Vulnerable Adult. Also, co-defendant, Griselda Railey was sentenced to three years of probation following her guilty plea. This case involved a mentally confused 84 year old Tucson woman who was financially exploited out of \$64,000 by the defendants who developed a relationship to assist her with her activities of daily living. Both defendants have been ordered to pay restitution to the victim. The investigation was led by SIS SA Jose Pimienta. Congratsl


