On October 20, 2020, I was contacted by David Lara. Lara is a San Luis resident who Yuma County has had contact with regarding the activities in San Luis. Lara sent me several screen shots of communication with a female by the name of Lizbeth Vasquez and a Facebook post from Brian De La Hoya, a representative of Yuma's 29th Precinct inviting citizens to a "ballot drop off car pool" in Somerton, Arizona.

In the communication involving Vasquez, there is an exchange regarding many ballots being seen in the vehicle of a female. A male by the name of Fernando Quiroz also reportedly witnessed the large number of ballots in the vehicle.

I spoke with Sgt. Hemstreet and requested that these subjects be located and interviewed regarding what they observed. Those interviews are pending at this time.

On October 22, 2020, I was informed that the fingerprint processing at the FBI would be significantly delayed. It was determined that the fingerprint evidence would be transferred to the Department of Public Safety laboratory in Lake Havasu City Arizona in hopes that the process would be faster.
